PATIENT REPEAT TEXT REMINDERS

New interactive output makes patient selection easier in version 5.22

TEXT ONLY

Repeat reminder functionality is currently implemented for text messages only, so patients must have mobile phone numbers recorded in the dispensary patient record. Repeats for all period of supply dispensing, except daily dispensing, are considered for reminders. Once reminded the patient is NOT suggested for a reminder again until their next repeat is due, to avoid nagging.

Repeat reminders use pre-set message templates. Set up at least one message text template in **6. Maintain message templates** first.

Contacts menu

- 1. Quick contact patient
- 2. Quick contact prescriber
- 3. Quick contact staff
- 4. Maintain contact lists
- 5. Patient repeat reminders
- 6. Maintain message templates

There are options to tailor the list of patients considered for messaging and there are also options to remove patients from the list presented before sending the message.

The aim is to get the reminders setup so that they can be run and sent without the need to review them at great length first.

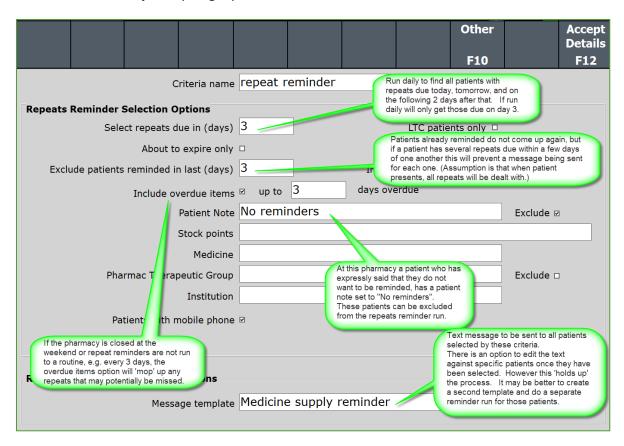


REMINDER CRITERIA

The feature can be run for everyone with a mobile phone who has a repeat expiring in the next e.g. week. It will consider all Rxs with outstanding available repeats except for daily dispensings.

It can be setup to remind specific groups of patients:

- LTC patients only
- Patients with overdue repeats as well as repeats due
- Patients identified with a particular note, or patients without the note
- Institution patients are automatically excluded, but can optionally be included
- Patients with just expiring repeats

Reminders are specific to a patient and their medicine history. It is possible to:

- Filter out patients already reminded about another repeat due, in the last few days
- Excludes daily dispensing
- Can optionally exclude Rx items for certain medicines (or therapeutic groups)

Once successfully reminded, a patient will not be considered again until another repeat matches the criteria set. Message history is available, either by patient or by batch.

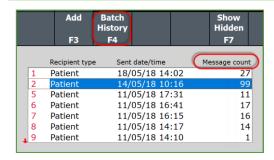
MESSAGE HISTORY (F4)

A record of all sent text message reminders is kept in the database.

These can be viewed:

- By batch (how many were sent on what day and to whom) F4 Batch History
- By patient from Patient Diary via F4 Sent History on the reminders screen
- Message by message on the patient history grid as a colour block like a diary item

BATCH REMINDER MESSAGE HISTORY



To see details of who was sent a message on a particular date, or to get an idea of how many messages are being sent, use the F4 Batch History function key.

Available from the **Patient repeat reminders** menu option.

PATIENT REMINDER HISTORY

Text reminder history is accessible from **F4 Sent History** for the patient who is highlighted on the reminder screen (see screen shot on page 2).

It is also available from the **Patient Diary** – using **F9 Repeat Remind**:



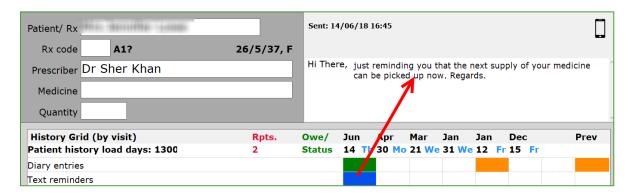


The history is also viewable from Patient History, F10 Other > Text reminders history.

PATIENT HISTORY GRID

A new line in the history grid shows individual text reminders:



Unlike other diary items, text reminders cannot be edited.

BULK EDIT PATIENTS

If a list of patients who were sent a reminder on a particular date, or in a particular date range, is required, there are new selection criteria in Bulk Edit Patients.

Where groups of patients are sent different reminders, they can be isolated, provided the messages are setup with different content. Just add distinctive message content (e.g. warfarin or due or waiting) into the Messages containing selection:

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF TXT MESSAGES

Currently patients who have email cannot be messaged through this new functionality. If reminders are wanted for patients with email addresses and no mobile phone, the **Repeats Due** report will need to be used to create a contact list.

If patients have a mobile phone recorded and an email address but have specified a preference to be emailed, identify them using the patient note (e.g. *Email reminders*) to exclude them from the txt message reminders.

Development is planned to include emailing in the new functionality.

Also planned is the handling of replies from patients to give a better end to end flow to the reminder.
